COVID-19 IMPACTS

We are still seeing the impacts through our increased requests for services. Our clothing program has seen a 100% increase from last year.

We have provided basic needs new clothing to 73 children in 2021 thus far. We foresee this need to continue in the fall with the return of school in person for all students.

We plan to send an additional 12 children to Dr. Pence for orthodontic treatment, this will be 24 NEW SMILES for 2021, equal to pre-Covid numbers.

WHAT IS A QUALIFIED CHARITABLE DISTRIBUTION?

A qualified charitable distribution is an IRA withdrawal that is paid directly from your IRA to a qualifying charity. While income tax is normally due on each traditional IRA distribution, the account owner does not need to pay taxes on the amount transferred to charity.
